# A. Painting

The model requires little painting. However if you do wish to paint it use water colours on the pyramid insert and satin white acrylic on the pyramids.

Colours:

- <u>Limestone yellow-brown</u> the interior insert of the Khufu pyramid (except the chambers).
- 2. <u>Satin white</u> the sphinx and queen's pyramids (if you add some), and the outside of the pyramids.

# B. Scoring

Use a ruler and a blunt point to score along all fold lines such as the edges of the pyramids and tabs, and all lines where scoring is indicated by the word "score"

Be sure to score the DOTTED line next to TABA on the Khufu pyramid. This is the HINGE that allows the pyramid to open, so score it well.


# C. Cutting

1. Use a sharp modelling knife and steel ruler to cut out the three square holes in the base - one hole for each pyramid. PLEASE BE CAREFUL - ASK AN ADULT TO HELP YOU IF NECESSARY.

2. Use sharp scissors to cut around each pyramid -BE CAREFUL NOT TO CUT THE TABS OFF!

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out the K hufu pyramid. Notice the **extended shaded narrow edges** on two small sides and one long side: these allow the pyramid to clip closed properly, so <u>don't cut them off</u>!

## D. Folding up

- Fold up the pyramids in the following order:
- 1. The Khafre (pro. cuff-ray) pyramid
- 2. The Men-ka-u-re (pro. Men-car- 00- ray) pyramid
- 3. The Khufu (pro. khoo- foo) pyramid the most complicated

# Folding TABS

a. Fold TABS on the outside edges of the pyramids UP - they will be glued under the base later.

b. Fold TABS that join each pyramid together (TAB A for the pyramid of Khafre and the pyramid of Menkaure; TAB D for the Khufu pyramid) DOWN – these glue inside each pyramid.

c. Fold TABS E & F of the insert for the Khufu pyramid, DOWN, i.e. back.

# E. Gluíng

We recommend using a CLAG or UHU glue stick for gluing. These will not wet the model and distort it

- a. Assemble the pyramids in the following order:
- í. The Khafre pyramíd
- ii. The Menkaure pyramid
- ii. The Khufu pyramid the most complicated

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE KHUFUPYRAMID:

- 1. Fold all sides first
- 2. Glue TAB D to opposite side of pyramid INSIDE THE HALF OF THE PYRAMID MARKED ON THE CUTOUT, i.e. THE OTHER SIDE OF THE DOTTED SCORING LINE TO TAB A. Do this CAREFULLY otherwise the pyramid may not close properly. Let this DRY THOROUGHLY BEFORE PROCEEDING
- 3. Glue insert into pyramid before inserting into base TAB E glues inside the side where TAB C is located; TAB F glues inside the side where TAB A is located. This allows viewing of the "internal chambers" of the pyramid Practice closing the pyramid to ensure insert allows room for the hinged side to close properly
- 4. Allow pyramids to thoroughly dry before gluing to the BASE
- b. Glue the pyramids to the base in the following order:
- 1. The Khafre pyramid
- 2. The Menkaure pyramid
- 3. The Khufu pyramid the most complicated

# SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR GLUING THE KHUFUPYRAMID TO THE BASE:

 The pyramid opens along the north-south line. Push pyramid through base so that TABB is on the side marked "West Cemetery (Tombs of the Nobles)". Then TABA will be on the north, and TABC on the south and TABB on the west. Glue TABSA, B, C in position. Hold firmly in position, pressing base over TABS


## 2. DO NOT GLUE other sides - <u>the black-shaded bottom edges allow the Khufu pyramid to catch</u> <u>the base board and remain closed if desired</u>


#### Further optional additions to your model:


- 1. Paint the Pyramids WHITE to represent the fine white limestone from Tura which once covered them
- 2. Add covered causeways and temples made from balsa wood. Paint these white
- 3. Glue the base to heavy card or thin wood for durability


4. Paint the base (not over the labels!) with SELLEY'S AQUADHERE or similar, and sprinkle sand, model railroad track ballast, or modelling flock to represent the desert sands. Avoid covering the labels.




















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
